### YOUTH LEADERSHIP AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AND DISCORD

**Leadership and Development:** Sponsored by FCA Foundation, Ford Motor Company, General Motors, and the Walters Family Foundation, this is a 16-week, curriculum-based program that molds LGBTQ+ Youth, ages 12-22, into leaders by providing them with career development skills and advocacy tools. Topics include resume writing, interview skills, race and racism, mental health, self-care, safer sex, risk reduction, and much more.

**Carl Ripberger Youth Drop-In Center:** A safe space for youth ages 13-18 to engage their peers in networking, fun, and learning. The Youth Drop-In is open Fridays and Saturdays from 4-9 pm and is staffed by adult allies (volunteers). The Drop-In Center is equipped with an Xbox One, board games, foosball, Netflix, Disney+, and much more.

**Discord Channel:** To replace the current absence of our on-site Youth Drop-In, Affirmations set up a DISCORD server. The Friday & Saturday 4-9 PM in-person option was replaced by this 24/7 access counterpart, for the duration of COVID restrictions. The youth are able to connect and express themselves in different themed "chat rooms" within our private server. This is offered to our youth ages 12-18 and is monitored by Affirmations' staff and adult volunteers.
